

ldon grew up with a dad who wasn't around much, which left him feeling angry and abandoned. So at age 12, he started partying and using drugs.

"My mom basically raised us. I was trying to fill a void that only God can fill."

His drug use spun out of control when his fiancée, who was his high school sweetheart, was shot and killed. "That sent me off the deep end... I was mad at God."

Eldon spent years caught up in addiction until he hit what he calls the triple H. "I was helpless, homeless and hopeless. Sleeping in a tent in my sister's backyard, and God kept bringing the Mission to mind."

The day he walked into Tri-City Union Gospel Mission, everything changed for Eldon.

"I believe the Lord brought me here," he says, smiling. "Before I had no purpose... no destination. Now it's all in God's hands, and He can do miracles." At the Mission, Eldon recommitted his life to God. He entered our New Life Program and found strength and support to help him face the future with faith.

"I learned more about God and the Bible, and that He's all about hope. God is good and He helps people at the Mission overcome old ways of living."

He also found a new calling – to minister to others who are hurting. "Now this is my mission: to help others and bring them to Christ," he says.

Eldon graduated from the program with new hope for the future. He knows that God will direct his steps and lead the way for him to be a servant of His kingdom.

"I would love to work at the Mission. Even when I live in my own place I still want to volunteer and be a part of what God is doing here."

This year, Eldon will be celebrating Christmas as a renewed creation, filled with the great joy of God's love. "When Jesus loves you, you can have love for others. Love conquers all."




