James never learned how to cope with loss in healthy ways. So when he was rejected by the military at age 18 and his plan for his life fell apart, he felt adrift.

"I was upset," he says. "So I fell in with a bad crowd and started using drugs."

James's addiction continued to escalate over the years... first after his dad passed away, and then again after the loss of his mom. He spent 34 years of his life trapped in drugs and despair.

James eventually became homeless on the streets for four years. Then one day, he simply had enough. "A homeless person is out of sight... out of mind for other people to see. I got tired of it."

The day he walked into Tri-City Union Gospel Mission was a turning point for James.

"God brought me here for a reason," he says, smiling. "I was looking for a good atmosphere with Christian people and I found freedom."

Only a month after James entered our long-term recovery program, he accepted Jesus into his heart in our chapel. The transformation in his life was immediately apparent.

"Since I accepted Christ, all my anger and bad habits are gone. I read my Bible every night before I go to bed."

Today, James has a job and continues to save his money while he looks for a place of his own. He's excited to see what God has planned for his life.

"Before the Mission, I didn't think about the future... I was just thinking about that day. Now all I see is blessings."

James is beyond grateful for this second chance in life – and says it's thanks to the love you've shown for a neighbor like him. "Now I have Christ in my life. Around here they call me smiley, because I'm always happy."
