

Chief grew up in a dysfunctional environment, feeling unwanted, insecure and unloved. Seeking acceptance as he grew older, he fell in with the wrong crowd and did whatever he felt necessary to survive. Finally, as a result of his destructive habits and behaviors, he was sent to prison.

While incarcerated, he began reading the Bible, witnessing to others and building a relationship with the Lord. When he was released – 20 years later – he had nowhere to go and the world had changed dramatically. But he took comfort in knowing God's Word remained constant.

Longing to start a new life in Christ, he came to Tri-City Union Gospel Mission.

"Everything I needed and wanted was here," he says. "The meals are great. They gave me clothes to wear. And I met sober people and made them my friends."

Most important, he says, "I was loved. And that's what brought about the change in me."

Today, as Chief prepares to move into transitional housing, he believes it is his duty and calling to

introduce Christ to others and support the Mission's work in the community. He hopes to continue his education and become an addiction counselor, helping men who have walked in his shoes.

Yet sadly, because of challenges related to his past, he knows his health is failing. But he doesn't fear the future. "When my time comes, I know I won't be alone. I'll die with Christ in my life and with my friends around me," he says.

Every day at the Mission, I would say my prayers: **Dear God, please help me.**And each day more help would come.

As Chief celebrates this Thanksgiving, he feels incredibly thankful for your compassion and support – and how it's given him a fresh start. "My heart was broken for most of my life, but God fixed it. My life has value to me now because of Tri-City Union Gospel Mission."




