Our current building is unsuitable and unsafe...

OLD AND WORN OUT

Built in 1914, our current building was originally the Twin City Phone Company. It has outdated electrical, plumbing, heating, and cooling.

A ROUGH LOCATION

With the busy street and new overpass, kids do not have a safe place to play. Crime rates and drug use in the neighborhood have also increased rapidly.

NOT ENOUGH SPACE

There's no other shelter in the Tri-Cities area, and when the current shelter is full, there's not enough space to serve our growing community. We often have to turn women and children away.

We try to place mothers and children in their own room, but it's not always possible. They commonly share rooms with individual women.

Many of our women and children are victims of domestic violence, drug abuse, and even sex trafficking, which lead to trauma. We do not have adequate space for important addiction recovery classes, life-skills training, or counselors to meet in private with residents.

The New Facility addresses the issues by providing

- Classrooms and offices
- Mini apartments for women and children
- Indoor and outdoor play spaces for children
- · Location in a clean, safe neighborhood
